

PUPILS SHOULD APPEAR SMART AND TIDY AVOIDING ALL EXTREMES OF DRESS. It is the overall effect that is of paramount importance.

Sixth Form Girls

No item need be purchased from the school shop however they are required to wear:

- A smart, tailored business suit with skirt, dress or trousers made from the **same matching fabric**. Hemlines of skirt must not be more than 7 cm above the knee. Cropped trousers must be on or below the knee and be tailored. Material must be of a conventional type, not leather or shiny fabrics.
- Shirts or plain tops only may be worn under the jacket:-
 - Shirts should be plain, striped or checked and have a collar. They must cover completely the waistband of trousers or skirt at all times and not show below the jacket.
 - Tops must be plain and have a high neckline.
- Jumpers or cardigans, if worn, must be lightweight, plain and suitable for wearing under a jacket.
- Shoes should be clean, smart, have a back and a maximum 6 cm heel. Suede shoes are not allowed. Shoes should be polishable. No UGG boots. Dark shoes are required for formal wear. Tights should be dark or neutral in colour. Ankle boots only allowed with full length trousers.
- Belts, if worn, should be discreet, leather, a maximum of 6 cm in width and appropriate for school wear.
- Jewellery should be simple – one ring, one bracelet, one necklace. Earrings, if worn, should be simple and appropriate for school wear and only one in each ear. Other piercings are not allowed.
- Hair should be well groomed.
- Make-up should be discreet.
- Coats should be smart, dark in colour and plain. They must cover the jacket. Casual jackets are not allowed.
- Away match dress: A smart, tailored skirt suit of matching fabric, white shirt or top, dark polishable shoes.

JUNIOR GIRLS (Years 9, 10 and 11)

- School jacket.
- School skirt. Hem line should be no more than 7 cm above the knee.
- Trousers (optional purchase). Navy pinstripe, tailored style which do not fully cover the shoe and are to be hemmed.
- Jumper (optional purchase) for colder weather – ‘V’ neck school jumper. No other jumper or cardigan may be worn during the school day.
- School shirt. This should be tucked into school skirt or trousers at all times.

All clothes should fit properly being neither baggy or unduly tight in order to allow safe freedom of movement within the school environment.

Junior girls must purchase the above items from the school shop.

- Scarves should be plain and short, or the school scarf.
- Shoes should be clean, smart, have a back and maximum 5 cm heel. They should be plain, dark and polishable. Canvas or suede shoes are not allowed.
- Coats should be smart, dark and plain. They must cover the jacket. Casual tops are not allowed.
- Jewellery – only small stud type earrings are allowed and only one in each ear. Other piercings are not allowed. A simple necklace is allowed.
- Hair should be well groomed.
- Make-up, if worn, must be discreet.
- Away match dress: school jacket, skirt, plain blue blouse and dark, polishable shoes.
