General Subscription. Items covered: Fees cover the normal curriculum. The General Subscription includes textbook loan, laundry, email, internet access, most extra-curricular activities, contribution to travel and accommodation when representing the School, pupils' personal accident insurance and personal voicemail when requested. An additional £15 per term is charged to pupils in the Lower and Upper Sixth to cover the cost of some of their major social functions.

Items not included in the General Subscription include instrumental music, riding, public examinations and membership of the Independent Schools Careers Organisation. These and other costs incurred by the School or the pupil will be charged as extras.

Instrumental Charges

£200 per first instrument per term (for up to 30 lessons per academic year). Subsequent instruments are charged at £190 per term.

Old Millfieldians' Society. £300 will be charged on the first term's bill for life membership of the Society.

Riding Charges

Riding Tuition	£14 to £42 per lesson
Polo	£350 per term (full-time), plus livery or £21 per group session (part-time)
Use of School horse	£13 extra per lesson
Full Livery	£130 per week

Note for new applicants to the School

The following fees are payable during the application process:

- Non-refundable Registration Fee to accompany completed Registration Form £120
- Acceptance Fee to accompany completed Acceptance Form £750
(The sum of £250 will be retained by the School and the balance of £500 will be credited against the final school bill. For those who do not take up their place, Millfield will retain the whole Acceptance Fee).

Change of Pupil Status

One full term's written notice from parents to the Headmaster is required on withdrawal of a pupil and on transfer from boarding to day status. Those failing to do this will be charged one term's fees in lieu of notice.

Payment of Fees

Please note that fees are due and payable to the Fees Office on or before the first day of each term. Interest will be charged at a monthly rate, detailed on the fees invoice, for fees that are not paid by the first day of term.
