Anyone age 5+ is welcome to enjoy riding at Millfield Prep School, from complete beginners who may take one lesson a week, to those who regularly compete nationally or in BS, BE and BD competitions and wish to stable their horse on campus to ride daily. We also have pupils that have been very successful racing. Our aim is for pupils to take pleasure in their riding and to have fun.

Coaching is delivered by experienced coaches. We offer BHS Challenge Award training and tests, and hold stable management sessions on Wednesdays and at the weekend, for those who wish to learn more about caring for horses. Lessons start at 7.30am, pupils can also ride at lunch time and at 4-5pm and 5-6pm. There are also other options for full-time riders and those that have more than one horse.
