Millfield Music School benefits from a vibrant and extensive concert calendar, featuring over 50 events each year with performances ranging from solo recitals to large-scale ensemble concerts, chamber music concerts to contemporary evenings, musicals and a biennial Concerto Concert.

Musicians can also take advantage of our high profile external performance calendar, including participation in renowned global music festivals and competitions, worldwide concert tours, and regular performances at Wells Cathedral. Millfield also hosts an International Concert Series and a programme of professional Masterclasses, featuring ensembles such as The King’s Singers, Tenebrae and BBC Big Band, and soloists including Pascal Rogé, Jennifer Pike and Joseph Moog.

The Music School employs 40 outstanding members of staff, including numerous active professionals, from world-renowned chamber ensembles and orchestras, to opera singers, conservatoire professors and ABRSM and Trinity examiners. The specialist staff lead a diverse and dynamic ensemble programme, with over 40 ensembles rehearsing weekly, including a significant programme of Chamber Music.

We are exceptionally proud of our musicians’ achievements in this wonderful arena. Many have secured places at major conservatoires and with national orchestras, choirs and musical theatre companies, including the National Youth Orchestra and National Youth Choir, and a number go on to read Music at university. Recent pupils have continued their musical education, often with scholarships, at highly-prestigious institutions such as Curtis Institute, Royal College of Music, Royal Academy of Music, Royal Northern College of Music, University of Oxford and the University of Cambridge. Our alumni have gone on to work in the music industry, as composers, performers and recording artists.
